

The chicken is being cooked and prepared by none other than DB's Smoking BBQ in Lucinda, so it is sure to be delicious! All other menu items will be made in-house, with the exception of desserts which will continue to be donated by parish members/families.

As a result of the menu change, there will be some obvious changes to the volunteer schedule. We will not be holding noodle-making days, nor will we be cooking noodles for the dinner. We also will not be asking anyone from the parish to prepare/cook chicken, nor will we be cooking any chicken or ham at the parish hall. The chicken for this year's dinner will be cooked by the vendor listed above.

So what does this mean for volunteers? WE STILL NEED YOU!! · We will still need volunteers for pre-dinner prep in the days leading up to the Picnic, and a schedule will be published as soon as possible. We will also need help on the day of the Picnic to do cooking/preparation in the kitchen, serve food from the buffet line, bus tables, wash dishes/pots, and other usual tasks.

Another big change – after many years of service to the Labor Day Picnic, Janet Fesenmyer is stepping down from coordinating the kitchen and dining room areas. Thank you, Janet!!

Any remaining quilts as well as a few quilts that won't be auctioned will be raffled off on the day of the Picnic at the Quilt Stand.

As of writing this update, the Labor Day Loot ticket and Farm to Table ticket are still being finalized. Once finished, they will be available for purchase in person as well as online through the Bidding Owl site (see above).

The usual food/supply donation list will be published in the bulletin over the next month. We will be looking for monetary donations for the cost of meat and other supplies for the dinner as well as in-kind donations of bread & rolls, pies, cakes, items for the Baked Goods Stand, and more.

Start thinking of Chinese Auction prizes! The Chinese Auction brings in a significant amount of revenue for the Picnic, especially since there is very little cost involved to put it together. We are always looking for "big" prizes or prizes that will draw interest and bring in crowds. More info on where to drop off donations will be released in the following weeks.

As a parish we have a special place in our hearts for tradition, and the Labor Day Picnic has been a major tradition at St. Michael's for over 130 years. We want to continue this tradition, but we must adapt it to what we as a parish are capable of accomplishing. We are excited to try some new things this year to help the Picnic continue to be viable. We hope you are excited to try something new, too!
