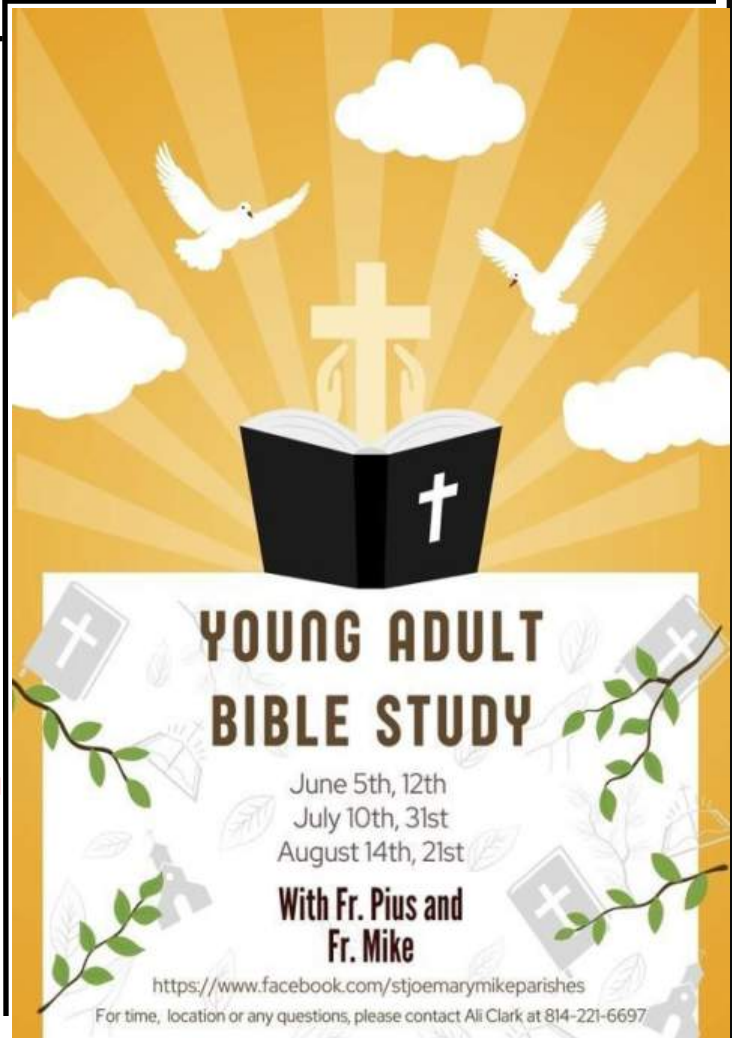
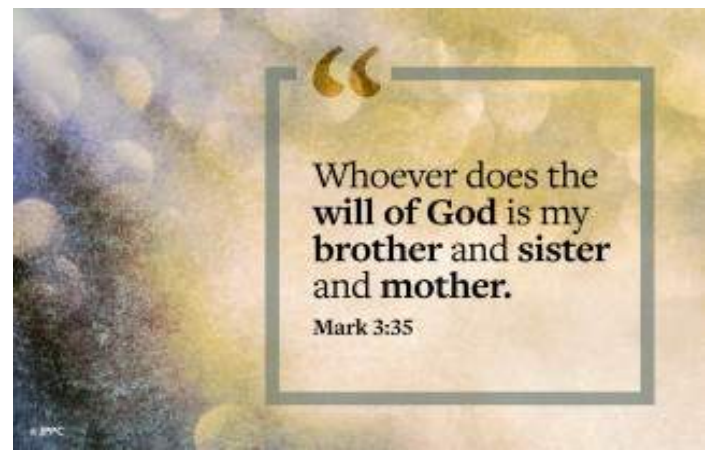
Festivities begin at 2:00 with Mass celebrated by Bishop Persico with a light reception to follow.
