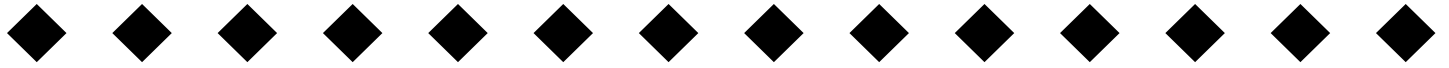

LITURGICAL MINISTERS

We are currently looking for assistance in four areas of our liturgies in each parish:

Ushers/Greeters: Ushers and greeters assist the larger community as ministers of hospitality through duties that include: greeting, taking up and organizing the collections.

Altar Servers: The server helps to prepare the altar by lighting the candles and making sure everything is in place. During Mass, the server assists the priest with the actions of Mass. Throughout the Mass the server pays attention to what is going on and participates by answering the prayers, singing the songs, standing and sitting along with the assembly.

Lectors: The lector is instituted to proclaim the readings from Sacred Scripture, with the exception of the Gospel. Lectors may also announce the intentions for the Universal Prayer and, in the absence of a psalmist, recite the Psalm between the readings.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) are laity who are commissioned as ministers for a specific place to distribute Holy Communion.


