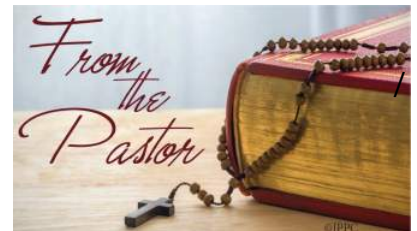
**Lectors:** The lector is instituted to proclaim the readings from Sacred Scripture, with the exception of the Gospel. Lectors may also announce the intentions for the Universal Prayer and, in the absence of a psalmist, recite the Psalm between the readings.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:** Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) are laity who are commissioned as ministers for a specific place to distribute Holy Communion.

### St Joseph Rosary Society

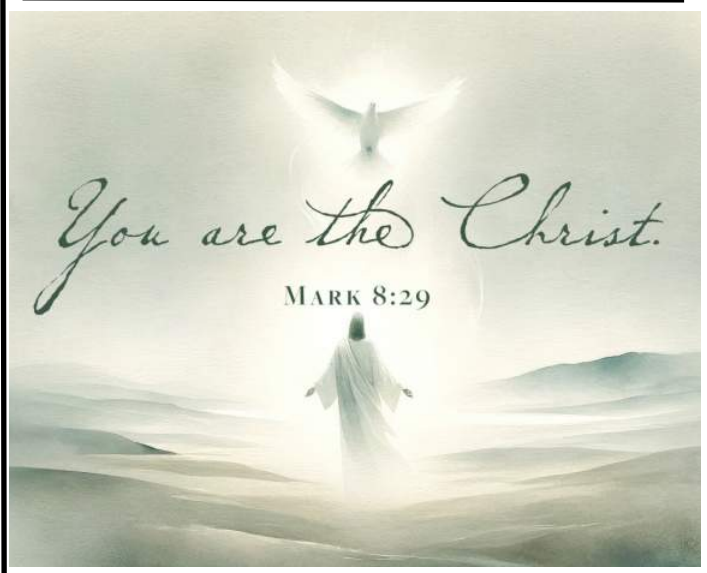

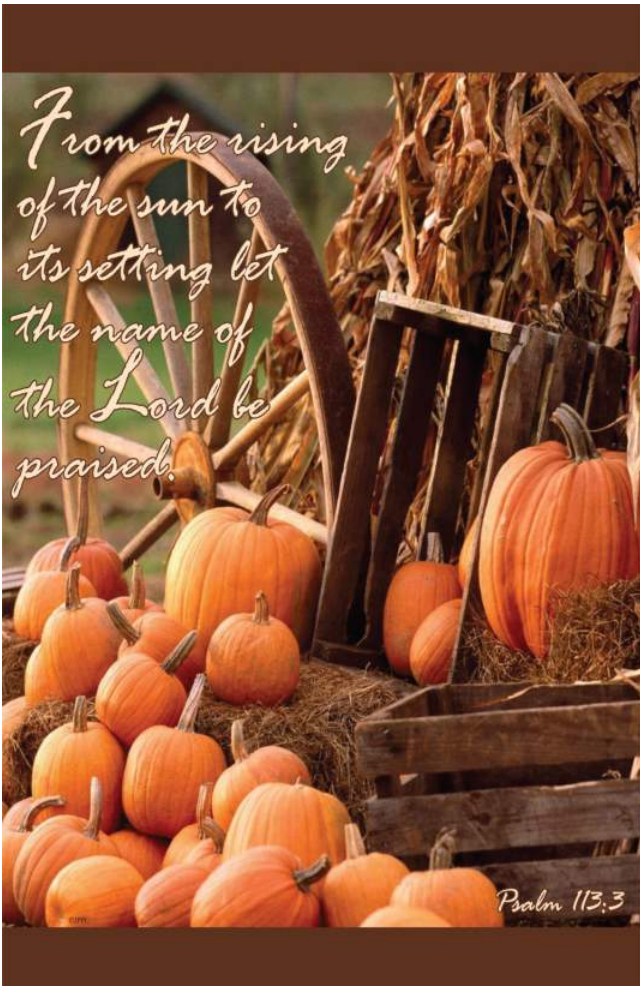
