I am happy to be starting up my “Pastor Column” again. Many things are happening in our parishes which we have communicated through homilies and announcements at the beginning of Mass, but with many of us moving about during the summer months, not everyone hears it.

One area that is changing this year is our **Religious Education Programs**:

1. **We are happy to welcome Emily Weaver** as the new Religious Education Director for St. Michael Parish. She will be taking over for Elizabeth Beal, who resigned last June. Elizabeth left a great foundation for Emily to build upon. We are excited to have her!
2. **Families with students in Kindergarten – 5th Grade** will have the option of attending classes at St. Michael in Fryburg or St. Mary in Crown. Unfortunately, St. Joseph Parish is no longer holding classes for this age group, which currently has eight children active in K – 5th grade religious education.
3. **Families with students in 6th – 8th Grade are invited to be a part of the Edge Nights.** Edge strives to help the youth feel a sense of belonging as they seek guidance, ask questions, and experience God’s love for them in an ever-changing world. This is our fourth year of the Edge Nights.
4. **Families with students in 9th Grade** are invited to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation. This will be our first year of bringing the students of all three parishes together for one program.
5. **Families with students in 10th Grade** and having received the Sacrament of Confirmation, are invited to attend small groups. We will invite young people to put their faith into practice: To learn to pray by praying together, to learn what discipleship is by discipling one another, and to learn from adult mentors who will journey to gether with them in exploring what it means to live our Catholic faith.

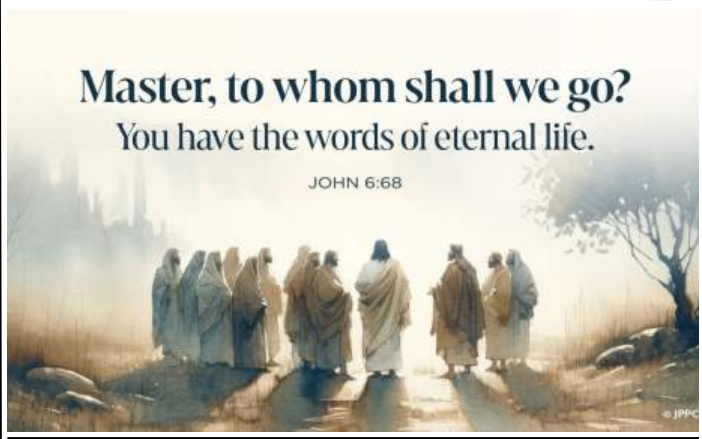

All other menu items will be made in-house, with the exception of desserts which will continue to be donated by parish members/families.
