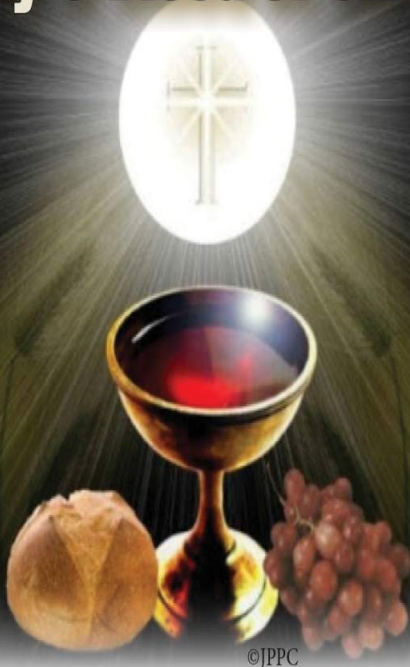


Reconciliation

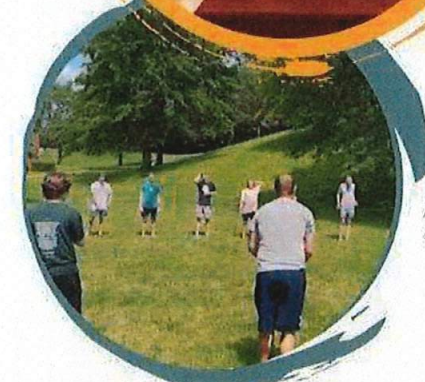
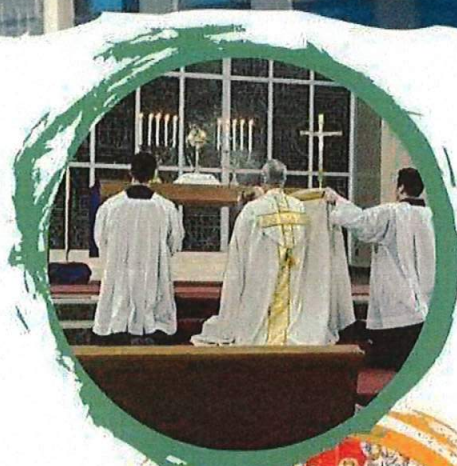
